Monthly: Juveniles, DOC “Log of Juveniles Detained or Confined”	KSA 38-2332(e) Statute requires DOC access to jail records related to juvenile detention or confinement. DOC has created a log of all juveniles detained or confined as defined in 28 CFR § 31.304 (b) : “to hold, keep, or restrain a person such that he is not free to leave, or such that a reasonable person would believe that he is not free to leave, except that a juvenile held by law enforcement solely for the purpose of returning him to his parent or guardian or pending his transfer to the custody of a child welfare or social service agency is not detained or confined within the meaning of this definition.” Instructions on the log sheet state reports are due “monthly (after the end of each month).”
